

Supplementary SAILING INSTRUCTIONS for the Christmas Pursuit Race 18th December 2016

1. The starting line will be between the mast on the Committee boat flying an orange flag and a Dan buoy carrying an orange flag. The starting line is **not** a gate on subsequent laps.
2. The course number will be announced and displayed at the signing-on sheets and on the port side of the Committee boat not later than 10h54. See below for courses.
3. To alert boats that a race will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with multiple sound signals at least one minute before a warning signal (numeral board zero) is displayed.
4. At 11h00 the numeral board zero will be displayed on the committee boat with one sound signal. At each subsequent minute the minute number will be displayed with a sound signal, until 11h45 or for as long as there are starters in the area.
5. Boats must start when the numeral board listed is displayed. A full list of start times is available in the office.
6. The race will end at 12h15. Finish ranking is the order of boats on the water at that time, the leader being finished from a RIB or other boat at 12h15.
7. Near the end of the race boats must keep within 50 metres of the centreline of their sailing leg especially when tacking up or downwind or they may not receive a finish.
8. Boats must continue sailing until finished with an individual sound signal from a RIB as soon as possible after 12h15. Each sailor is also requested to note the boats next in front and behind, especially if the rescue service is stretched.
9. These Sailing Instructions over-ride any Club S.I. with which they conflict.

COURSES

- The course will be selected from courses 1-9 below, based on the wind direction and strength.
- Marks are listed in order by letter followed the rounding direction (p-port, s-starboard).
- The course number will be announced and displayed ashore and on the Committee Boat.
- In the event of exceptional wind conditions, the Race Officer may specify an alternative course, **9**, displayed using course boards on the Committee Boat.
